PERSONAL WORD

Hey Neighbor!

This Sunday, we will close out our "Hey Neighbor" sermon series with Connect Sunday, our annual opportunity to make our ministry commitments for the year. In an effort to look more technologically advanced than we actually are, all our registrations this year will be online. (Visit www.trinitybirmingham.com) We will even have some folks here at the church on Sunday to help you sign up if you're not internet-savvy. We will also have an awesome free giveaway for every man, woman, and child (member, visitor, or undecided).



When we join the church, we make a five-fold commitment – a five-part promise – to live out our faith in prayer, presence, giving, service, and witness. In a world where words are cheap and promises are easily broken, I remain convinced that one of the first steps in healing this broken world is learning to keep our word. The commitment we make when we unite with the Body of Christ is as significant as a marriage vow, or the promises made for an infant at baptism. We give our word, that here at Trinity, we will put our faith into action.

Throughout scripture, it's made clear that (as James puts it), "faith without works is dead." That doesn't mean that we do good things to make ourselves better people, or that we need to accumulate enough brownie points to get in God's good graces. Instead, it suggests that genuine faith, the kind that grabs your heart and won't let go, cannot help but being expressed in outward ways. Like the bread and wine at communion or the water we use in baptism, our actions are not the substance of our faith, but they are a symptom of it. Our living becomes sacramental – an outward and visible sign of our inward, spiritual hope.

Faith that isn't coupled with action is like an unsung song, a stack of kindling without a spark, or a beautiful painting that never makes it out of the paint can. Don't get me wrong, this is a great church if you just want to sit on the sidelines. It's easy to imagine that somebody else will serve if we don't, someone else will give if we won't. But it's not just the church that loses when that's how we think. When our belief is not expressed in service, our faith will always be less important to us, and less powerful.

And the best news of all is, there is something at Trinity you can do. There is something that you can do for the glory and honor of Jesus Christ, whether it's singing a song or stuffing an envelope, digging a ditch or mentoring a child. God has equipped this church with everything she needs to change the world, but those resources are useless if we don't employ them for God's purposes. Service is the language of faith, the ultimate expression of what we believe.

This Sunday, I hope you will join us for worship as we commit ourselves to the ministry of the church, and in doing so, keep our word.
